We negotiated for the workshop participants a special price of 125.80 Euros single, 145.80 double, including breakfast and taxes. Parking is 9 euros/day. Participants staying at the hotel will be able to use the fitness center including Sauna, Turkish bath, Jacuzzi and cardio-training, swimming pool, etc. for free. Note that in order to be insured a room at this tariff you must imperatively reserve it before March 15, 2005. Please contact the hotel directly, mentioning CONGRES GREQAM in order to get the preferential tariff. Modifications or cancellations will be possible at no costs until shortly before the workshop. Likewise, special treatments at the spa must be booked well in advance.

A list of other hotels within easy walking distance will be posted soon. It will include both less and more expensive hotels.

Rooms are in high demand in Aix en Provence. WE THEREFORE STRONGLY SUGGEST THAT YOU BOOK VERY EARLY.

Coming to Aix en Provence

The nearest airport is Marseille (Marseille-Marignagne), the nearest high-speed train station (TGV) Marseille or Aix en Provence TGV.

Taxis from Marseilles' airport (Marseille-Marignane) cost about 40 euros, from the train station Aix TGV 30 euros one way, a little bit more at night or on Sunday. There are also shuttle buses from both places, for less than 10 euros one way. The bus stop is within walking distance from the hotels if you travel lightly. Otherwise, a taxi should not cost more than 7 or 8 euros.

We strongly suggest your NOT renting a car for the time of the workshop: Cars are at best useless, at worst a nuisance in Aix. You may, however, want to rent a car before or after the workshop. The country side around Aix is rich in beautiful sceneries and monuments, and well worth a visit. See http://www.aixenprovencetourism.com/uk/ for information. You can download two brochures on Aix, its surroundings, and the Provence. The site also includes also a list of hotels, restaurants, and sightseings in Aix).

If you are willing to share a room, a taxi, or a rental car, please send a message to all prospective participants saying so and indicating your arrival place and time.

A convenient description and a map of the road itinerary from your point of entry to the Aquabella hotel can be found on www.mappy.com. If you are coming from Marseilles airport, indicate Marignane as the departure place, and rue des Etuves, Postcode 13090, as the arrival place. Aix en Provence TGV (the train station) is halfway between Marseille-Marignane and Aix.

Conference fee

The conference fee will be 350 Euros. It includes a buffet on June 2, luncheons and on the 3 and 4 June, a gala dinner on June 4, and coffee breaks on the 3rd and 4th. It also includes a copy of the book we are editing in honor of Suresh. Drinks with the meals are included.

Details about the payment will be given later. Expect to be asked to pay before March 1st, 2005, with almost total refund possible until April 15.

Accompanying persons

Accompanying persons can participate to the gala dinner against payment of 90 euros. The fee for participating to the buffet, lunches, gala dinner, and coffee breaks is 200 euros.
